Select: [Print Driver]

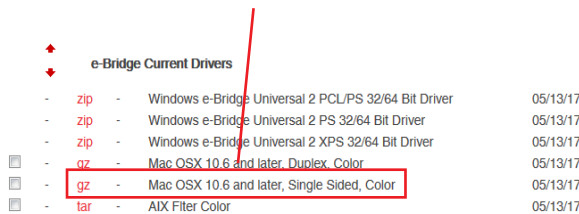


Next page enter model and Press: [Search]

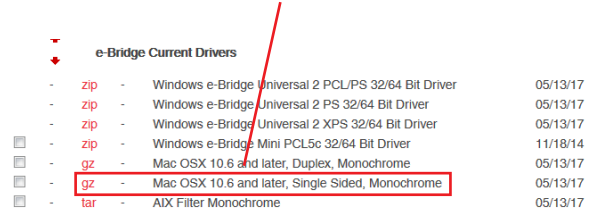


Scroll Down To: [e-Bridge Current Driver], You will be selecting the Single Sided Driver

Color Driver for Mac

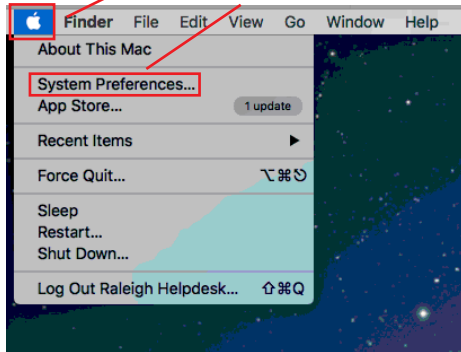


Monochrome Driver for Mac

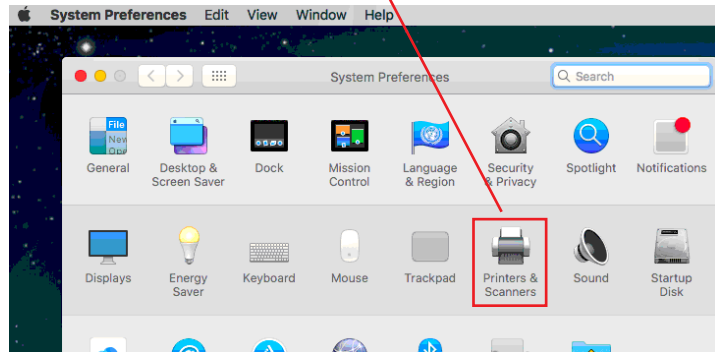


The driver will download to your computer. Once this is done, proceed to "unbox" the driver. Run the setup as you would normally install program and such on your Mac computer. Once this is done, proceed to System Preferences to setup the driver.

Press the Apple icon and System Preferences

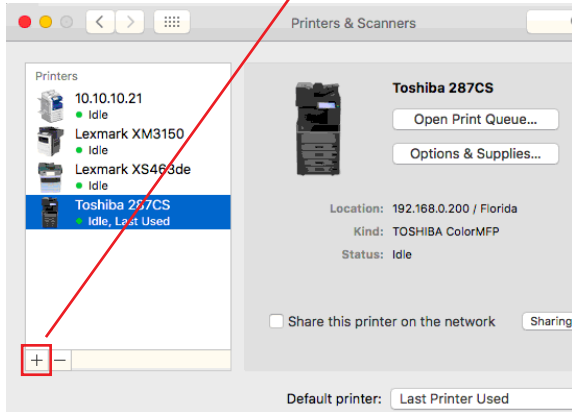


Press Printers and Scanners

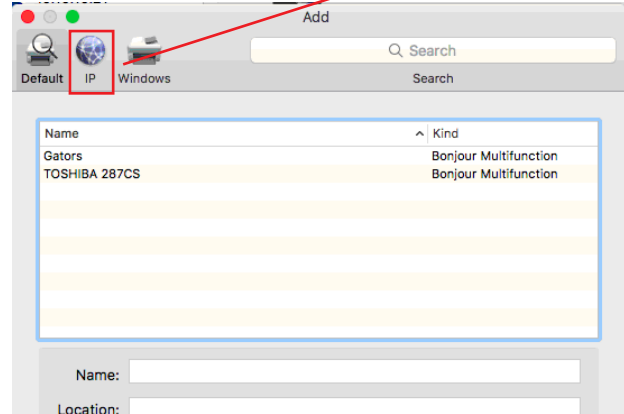

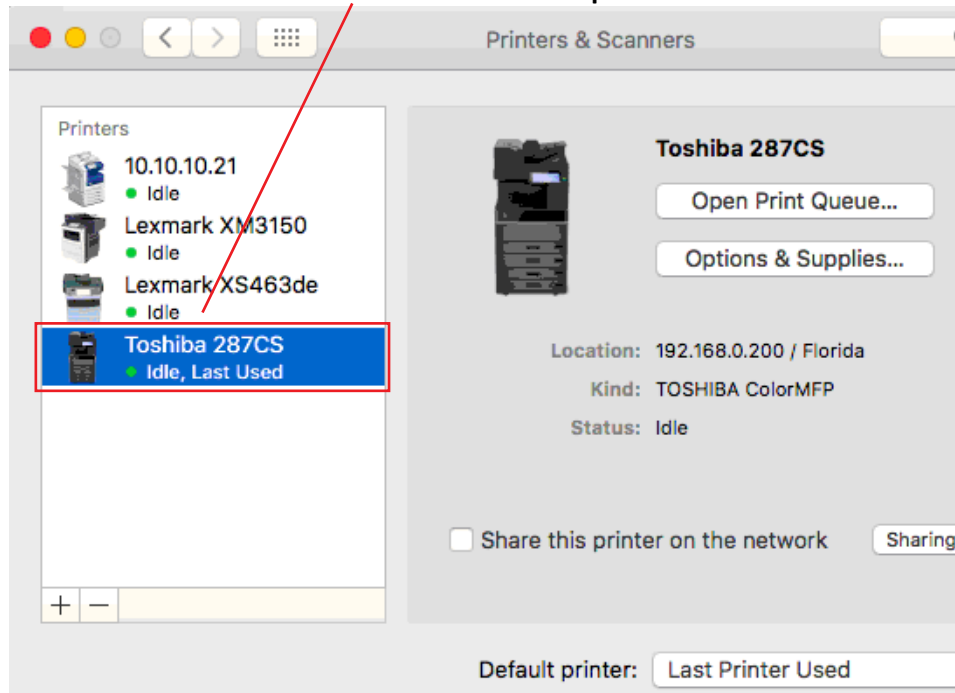

Press Add to install the driver on your Mac computer

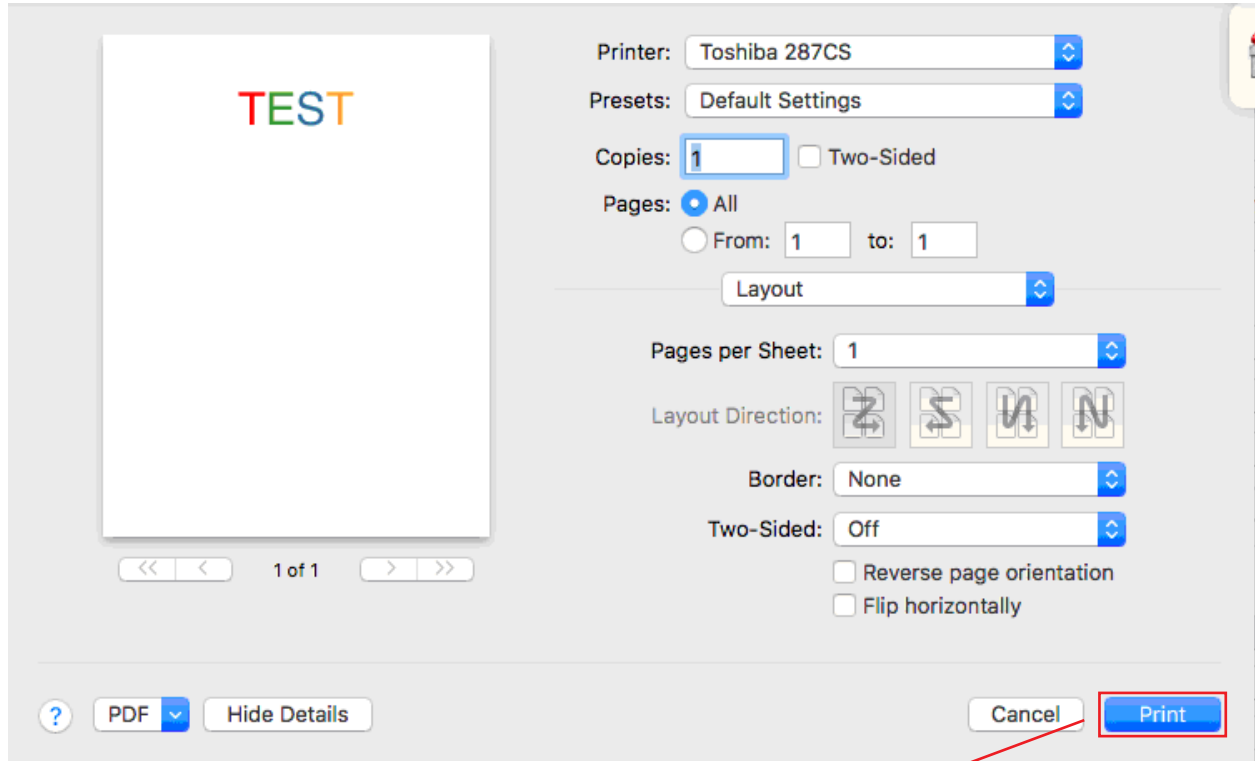
